



Accessibility Policy

Airhead Education Ltd is a software development company and creator of the market leading cloud desktop for schools, colleges and universities known as 'Airhead'. As a company, Airhead Education Ltd is committed to creating great user interfaces that can be used by anyone regardless of age, disability, capability or technology.

We look to the accessibility best practices and standards defined by the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C) Web Accessibility Initiative (WAI) [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines 2.0 \(WCAG 2.0\)](#), conforming at Level AA. This page summarises our approach when designing and developing our products.

General principles

- We provide simple, consistent navigation.
- We use plain language to convey information, keeping our sentences short and to the point.
- We use plain, easy to read font types.
- We use well-established interaction patterns wherever they exist.
- We break up complicated tasks into simple steps.
- We break up complex information into logical groupings.

Visual design and typography

- We ensure a good level of contrast between foreground and background elements.
- We allow users to choose colour schemes that suit them.
- We ensure that our interfaces are compatible with browser zooming.

Images and other media

- We use universally recognised symbols for icons wherever possible.
- We ensure that any images in the interface that aren't just decoration have a text description.

- We ensure that any audio content we provide has a text alternative.
- We don't use accessibility-problematic technologies such as Flash.
- Navigation via the keyboard or other assistive technologies
- We ensure that our applications can be used via the keyboard as well as the mouse.
- We provide access keys to allow users to jump directly to different parts of the user interface.
- We ensure that user interface components comply with the standards for assistive technologies such as screen readers and alternate input devices.
- We ensure that all controls have programmatically-associated text labels.

Development standards

- We use valid, semantic HTML and valid CSS.
- We augment mark-up with WAI-ARIA attributes, roles, states, and properties.
- We perform periodic audits of our site against WCAG and WAI checkpoints, and have a programme of continual improvement.
